

A Texas Gathering for NSFVA set for April 26 & 27, 2019.

This gathering will consist of harnessing tips and demos of several types of harness. There will be some stage coach driving and exhibitions as well as driving of other horse drawn vehicles. This is an informal gathering of people with a common interest of stagecoaches and wagons. We hope to share knowledge and ideas during this group activity.

This is the peak of our wildflower season in Central Texas and the Hill Country. Try to make a vacation of this with points of interest in this area being Fort Worth Stockyard and Sundance Square approximately 100 miles north west of the ranch. Dallas with its JFK site and other points of interest is about 85 miles north of the ranch. Austin is 150 miles south also. It is the start of the beautiful hill country, Fredericksburg, Lukenbach and LBJ ranch are some of the attractions.

We will open the ranch for visitors Wednesday April 24th for RV camping and trail rides. Bring your wagons and teams and riding animals to take advantage of our rural area. We will remain open thru the next Wednesday May 1st. Canton Trade Days starts Thursday May 2. It is the largest in the state and open through Sunday. For those that want to fly, you can come in DFW or Love Field in Dallas. Waco Regional Airport is about 55 miles west. We can furnish transportation from Waco Regional to our ranch and back if needed.
