Upcoming Events:

6th Annual Conference – "Hanging Out in Virginia City, MT" July 10-14, 2013

Held in conjunction with Virginia City's 150th Anniversary Celebration, this event is sure to immerse our attendees in the local history and culture while we explore the bygone era of staging and freighting and enjoy the rustic beauty of southwest Montana. We will see how stage coaches, freight wagons and many other wooden-wheeled vehicles pulled by horses and mules made it possible to develop the area and discover gold.

Our gathering kicks off on Wednesday, July 10^{th,} with a Welcome Picnic and early registration at the Brewery Park in Virginia City from 3pm until 7pm. Thursday morning will find us in Nevada City with a continuation of registration followed by a walking tour of the town, a gold panning demonstration, and ending with the tour of a vehicle collection (coaches, wagons, etc.) Friday will be devoted to presentations and speakers. Topics covered will include local roads, wagon routes, conservation and preservation of wooden-wheeled vehicles and the history related to area gold mining, the people, and the animals. The day will conclude with a public display of privately owned vehicles and a Chuckwagon Pitchfork Steak dinner in Nevada City.

Saturday will bring a tour of a local ranch where we will see a historical stage-stop and one of the original freighting routes to the area, followed by a presentation by the Montana Heritage Commission. The day will finish up with a dinner and dance hosted by the Ruby Dell Ranch in Alder, MT. Sunday allows a choice of two morning options: 1) 10am Cowboy Church Services with local pastor Tom Luksha or 2) Auto tour of Alder Gulch. The afternoon will be set aside for self-promotion and project/knowledge-sharing at the Virginia City Gymnasium. Please note that Saturday and Sunday tours require early sign up.

This event promises to be an action-packed adventure, with a little bit for everyone! For more information on attending our conference, please refer to the informational packet which accompanies this newsletter.
